About the Event

The Research and Development Cell (RDC), Institution's Innovation Council (IIC), and Innovation and Startup Cell, Assam Don Bosco University, in association with the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), Government of India, organized an **Awareness Program on Intellectual Property Rights** on 4th February 2023 from 10:30 AM onwards. The program was held under the flagship of **Kalam Program for Intellectual Property Literacy and Awareness Campaign (KAPILA)**.

Resource Persons

The resource persons for the event was Shri Sumit Kumar, Examiner of Patents and Designs at Indian Patent Office, Kolkata. Shri Sumit Kumar completed his Master of Science (Chemistry) from Delhi University in 2018.

About KAPILA

KAPILA is a scheme of the Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell and AICTE under which financial assistance is provided to the institutions that are part of the Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) for filing patents.

The objective of KAPILA is to recognise, facilitate and felicitate the Intellectual Property, innovations, and best practices in HEIs.

KAPILA will help in establishing the much required IP filing ecosystem in a large number of education institutions and thus create a culture of systematically protecting new ideas, research, and innovation having national and global relevance.

The expected outcomes of KAPILA are:

1. Awareness creation regarding the need of IP filing, mechanism and methodology involved in filing IP in India and globally, especially amongst students and faculty of higher education institutions.

- 2. Establishing the much required IP filing ecosystem in a large number of education institutions and creating a culture of systematically protecting new ideas, research, and innovation having national and global relevance.
- 3. Program will set the foundation for the institute's participation in MoE's Innovation and Entrepreneurship initiatives such as IIC, ARIIA, Hackathons, NISP, National Innovation Contest, and YUKTI 2.0 and related programs at MIC and AICTE.
- 4. Strengthening the connection of institutions located in Himalayan/North Eastern region/Aspirational Districts with national innovation and entrepreneurial ecosystem enablers.
- 5. Active participation and involvement of students, faculties and staff Sensitization and vibrant IP filing ecosystem in HEIs
- 6. Filing at least 10,000 patent applications per year

Report of the Event

The program started with Shri Sumit Kumar briefly explaining the purpose of the awareness programme on Intellectual Property Rights. In his talk, he explained what is tangible and intangible property, what is intellectual property rights, and what are the different types of intellectual property rights. He then explained each of the intellectual property rights, namely, copyright, trademarks, patents, geographical indications, plant varieties, industrial designs, and semiconductor integrated circuit layout designs. He also provided examples of each type of intellectual property rights. His talk also covered the career opportunities in the domain of intellectual property rights.

At the end of his talk, Shri Sumit Kumar clarified the doubts that the participants had.




Fig 1: Presentation by Shri Sumit Kumar




Fig 3: Geo-Tagged Photo




Fig 5: Flyer for the Program




Fig 10: Certificate of Appreciation for institute
